Among a small forested area and three exceptionally beautiful beaches you will find a truly tropical paradise. Here, the mountains meet the sea, the beaches are covered with coconut palms and the ecosystem is teeming with land, air and sea species.

During the 2 hour walk on the park trails, you will have the opportunity to see the endangered squirrel monkey, (Manuel Antonio boasts the largest population in the world). In addition you will see various colorful and majestic birds, white faced monkeys, sloth's, brilliantly colored land crabs, and colorful butterflies.

The average temperature is around 80 Fahrenheit degrees, making this walk, very comfortable and pleasant.

After the walk, you will enjoy a tropical lunch, right on the beach!
